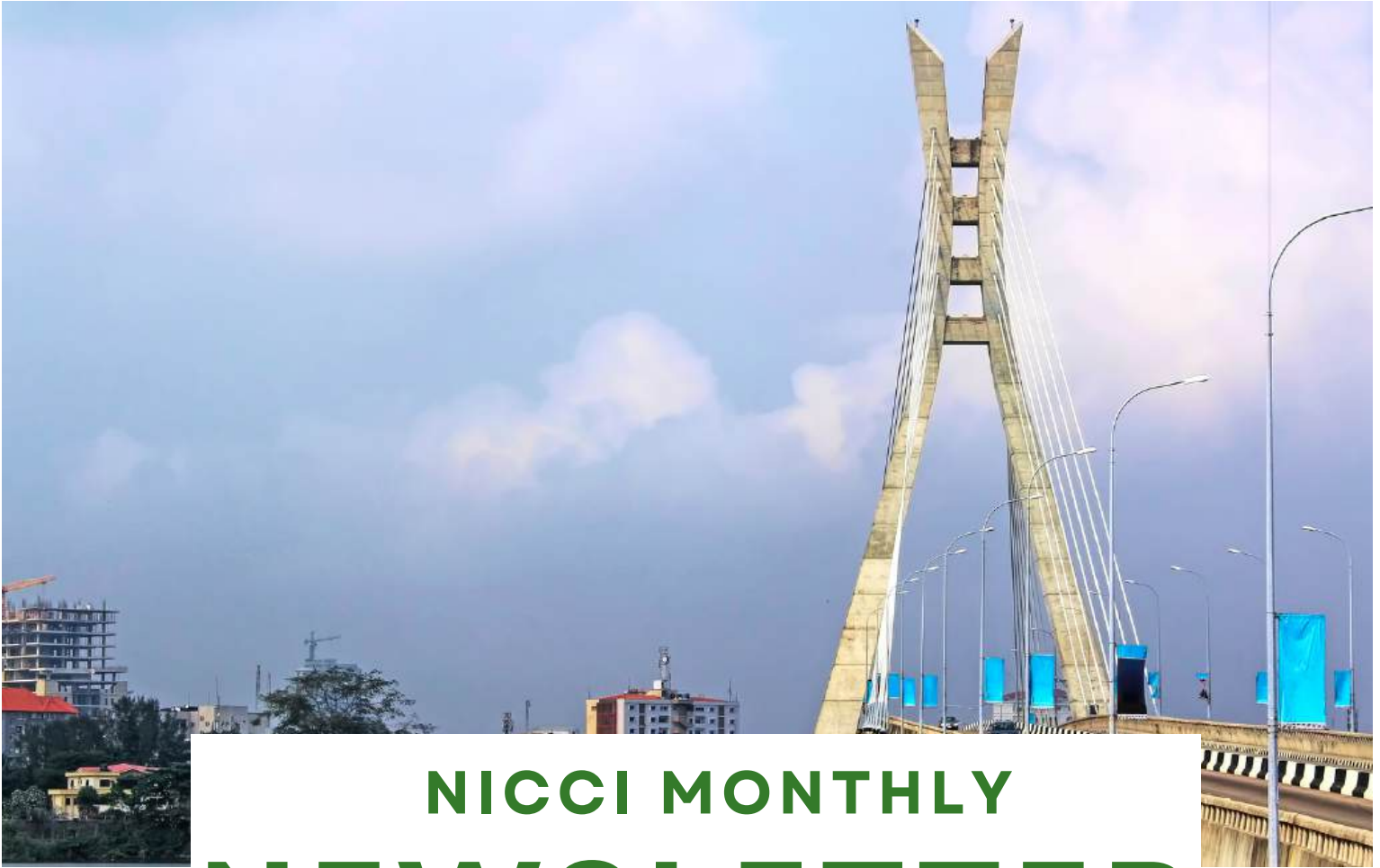

The Pavilion featured a diverse range of Indonesian manufacturers and exporters presenting innovative food products, beverages, ingredients, and consumer goods to the Nigerian market.

NICCI worked closely with the Indonesian Embassy and ITPC Lagos to facilitate productive business engagements. The presence of **His Excellency Bambang Suharto**, Indonesian Ambassador to Nigeria, further underscored the shared commitment of both countries to strengthening economic cooperation.
